Annexure – Class 6 (FD&D) Rule Changes for the 2024/25 Policy Year

The Class 6 (FD&D) Rule Changes are outlined below.

The revisions to the FD&D Rules arise from a general Review aimed at modernising and re-numbering the text. Therefore, there is no change to the scope of cover and there are no material changes in the Rules except to ensure alignment with the Pooling Agreement. The main objectives behind the Review were to:

- a. introduce a hierarchical numbering system for the Rules to aid cross-referencing and greater online accessibility; and
- b. modernise the language of the Rules, including removing gender-specific terms (e.g. amending “seaman” to “seafarer”).
